- 4) Easter Sunday = the Resurrection of Jesus from the "slavery of death"

- 6) The Christian "Passover" through the waters of Baptism
- 7) The blood of the lamb "painted on the doorposts of the Christian soul"
- 8) Jesus the new Moses leads his people through the waters of baptism
