RCIA HO Class 26 Examination OF Conscience (based on the 10 Commandments)

When did I make my last confession? Did I deliberately fail to mention my mortal sins at the time? Did I fulfill the penance? Since my last confession, have I received Holy Communion unworthily, i.e. aware that I have committed a mortal sin? How do I approach the sacrament of penance? What, if anything, has kept me away from the confessional? Am I resolved, with the help of God's grace, to try to lead a better Christian life, in a fuller spirit of friendship with Our Lord, through faith hope and charity?

1. "I am the Lord your God; you shall not have strange gods before me." Do I love God above all else? Have I been angry with God or lost my faith in him? Am I happy and secure in my identity as a Catholic, or do I try to mask that identity? Do I embrace all that the Church proposes for my belief in matters of both faith and morals? Do I strive to deepen my faith, or have I jeopardized that faith by carelessly exposing myself to anti-Catholic teaching or thinking? By the way I live, am I helping to proclaim the Gospel? Do I pray regularly with sincerity, devotion, and gratitude? In times of temptation do I seek Our Lord's help? Have I yielded to despair? Alternatively, have I presumed God's mercy in order that I may continue some particular sin?

2. "You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain."

Do I use the Lord's name with reverence or have I shown lack of respect for it in conversation or exclamations? Have I kept any promises made under oath? Have I given scandal (lead someone) into sin? Do I show respect for the Blessed Mother and the Saints?

- 3. "Keep holy the Sabbath day." Have I missed Mass on Sunday or holy days of obligation? Do I try to avoid unnecessary work on those days, in keeping with joy proper to the Lord's Day? Do I assist at Mass with devotion? Am I generous in the weekly collection? Do I observed the one hour fast before receiving Holy Communion? Do I perform some act of penance on Fridays?
- 4. "Honor your father and your mother." FOR PARENTS: Have I taken the necessary steps to ensure that my children receive a Christian education, as well as the sacraments appropriate to their age? Do I encourage them to learn and say their prayers? Do I set a good example for them? Do I show interest in the TV programs and movies they watch, the books and magazines they read, in the friends they make? Do I teach them to respect lawful authority and to responsibly use their freedom? Do I foster their love and trust? Do I abuse them in any sense or cause them to lose heart? Do I fail to correct them when necessary? FOR CHILDREN: Have I been disobedient to my parents? Do I show them respect and affection? Do I neglect either their material or spiritual needs? Do I fulfill my responsibilities at home? Have I fought with my brothers or sisters? Have I neglected my studies or cheated on exams or homework? Do I always follow school rules? 5. "You shall not kill."

Have I physically injured anyone? Have I maintained hatred or anger against someone? Have I lost my temper or offended another with my words? Did I try to make amends, or on the other hand, have I refused an offer of reconciliation? Am I ever envious or jealous? Do I rejoice at another's misfortune? By word or example, was I an occasion of sin for another person? Have I driven recklessly or under the influence of alcohol? Have I neglected my health? Do I abuse drugs, alcohol, or food? Have I procured an abortion or counseled another to do so? 6. "You shall not commit adultery." 9. "You shall not covet your neighbor's wife." Have I committed adultery or fornication vacation? Have I engaged in any type of impure act either alone [masturbation] or with someone else? Do I avoid occasions of sin against purity by exercising care in the company I keep, the books and magazines I read, the television programs and movies I watch? Do I deliberately engage in lustful thoughts? Do I use impure language? Do I practice the virtue of modesty in my attire? FOR MARRIED PEOPLE: Am I in a valid marriage? Have I been faithful to my spouse in desire, as well as in deed? Have I or my spouse made use of any method of artificial contraception, especially one that can function as an abortifacient (e.g. The pill or "the shot")? Did I encourage my spouse to be sterilized or did I undergo such a procedure? Have I informed myself of the church's teaching on responsible parenthood? Am I selfish with regard to not having children? Have I engaged in unchaste sexual acts with my spouse, i.e. completed sexual acts not open to the transmission of life? 7. "You shall not steal." 10. "You shall not covet your neighbor's goods."

How about a stolen anything? Am I in possession of anything that I believe may have been stolen? Do I live beyond my means or fail to pay my debts? Do I pay my taxes? Have I engaged in any type of fraud or cheating? Am I envious of my neighbor's goods? Do I have an unhealthy attachment to material things? Have I damaged another's property? Do I give alms according to my means? Am I prepared to make sacrifices for the welfare of others? Do I give my employer an honest day's work? Do I pay my employees a fair wage? Am I honest in all of my business dealings? Do I use the gifts that God has given me in a responsible manner? Do I practice self- denial to get control of my passions or appetites?

8. "You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor."

Have I told lies to avoid embarrassment, enhance my image in the mind of others, or get out of a difficult situation? Have I taken away someone's good name by false accusation or by unnecessarily revealing their faults? Do I engage in rash judgment or gossip? Do I divulge secrets? Do I unjustly question the motives or intentions of others? Have I failed to defend someone who was innocent?

FINALLY: Do I love my neighbor as myself, or do I sometimes use people, look down on them, or treat them with contempt? Have I tried to alleviate the suffering of others? Do I live my life with the sense that this world is a preparation for the next? Am I a patient in bearing trials and disappointments out of love for Jesus' sacrifice for me on the cross?

1. Have I missed Mass on Sunday or Holy Days due to my own fault? Do I pray to God regularly?
2. Do I fast for one hour before receiving Holy Communion?
3. Have I used bad language, swear words, or curse words.
4. Have I used the name of Jesus and God in ways I should not have? Have I disobeyed my parents or teachers?
5. Have I talked back to them?
6. Have I been mean to my brothers and sisters?
7. Have I fought with anyone, or made fun of anyone?
8. Have I been angry with anyone or spoken badly of anyone to others to others?
9. Have I led anyone else into sin by encouraging them to do something wrong?
10. Have I watched anything I should not have in movies, on television, or on the internet? Have I
listened to conversations I should not have?
11. Have I stolen anything?
12. Have I kept anything that does not belong to me?
13. Have I broken anything that belonged to someone else?
14. Have I lied? Have I cheated in school or in games?
